Health and Insurance Benefits

RTO/ERO **owns** and offers its members superior, competitive group Semi-Private Hospital, Extended Health Care and Dental plans through Johnson Inc.

Extended Health Care - In-Province Benefits such as Prescription Drugs, Paramedical Practitioners, Vision, Aids and Appliances, Diagnostic and Other Procedures, Private Duty Nursing, Transportation/Ambulance, Accidental Dental, Educational Programs and Referral Treatment Outside Canada are reimbursed according to the various maximums and limits as outlined in the Health Insurance Plans Booklet.

Extended Health Care Out-of-Province /Canada Travel Benefit provides for *any number of trips of up to 62 days* in duration, eligible Travel Emergency Medical expenses incurred due to an accident or sudden and unforeseen illness while travelling outside your province of residence, including outside Canada, reimbursed at 100% to a **maximum of \$1,000,000 per trip per insured person with no deductible**. It also includes Trip Cancellation up to \$6,000 per insured person for the pre-paid, non-refundable portion of your travel arrangement costs for trips that were booked prior to departure from your province of residence.

How to Join . . .

It's not automatic. You must apply!

Whether you are about to retire or have already retired, once you leave the school system we have no way of contacting you. To join our mailing list and receive further information, you must send a note, or email our Membership Chair, with your name, complete home address with postal code and phone number, and email address if you have one. Then, you will receive an information package to get you started.

But membership in RTO/ERO is not automatic. You will need to fill in and mail the forms. Be sure to indicate on the back of the Membership Application that you want to become a member of **District 8 London/Middlesex**. There is a separate form to apply for Group Health Benefits and Insurance.

As a "Full" member, the membership fee ranges from \$50 and is calculated based on your pension at the rate of \$1.25 per \$1000 of gross annual income. The fees are collected as a deduction from your January OTPP pension cheque. District Membership is included in your Provincial Membership.
